- How to become a Project Talk Host

Hosts receive a \$300 stipend to host one community event with a goal of 20 participants. Project Talk will provide all materials, and our team will travel to the event to assist with facilitation. 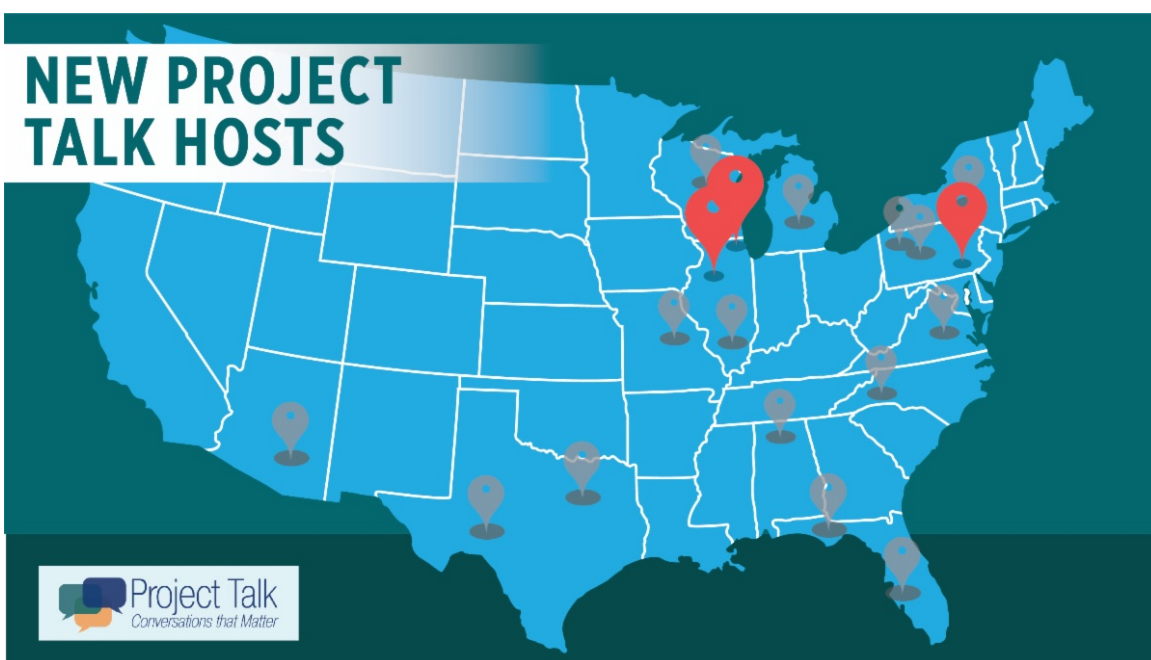

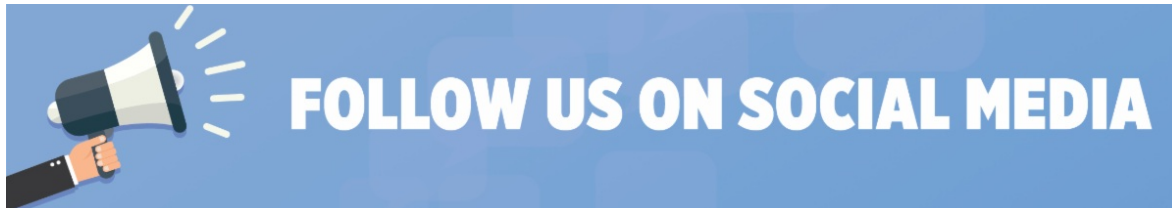


Image: Project Talk event in Creve Coeur, MO
