Host Requirements:

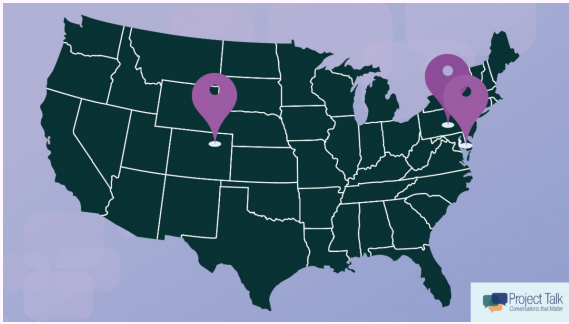

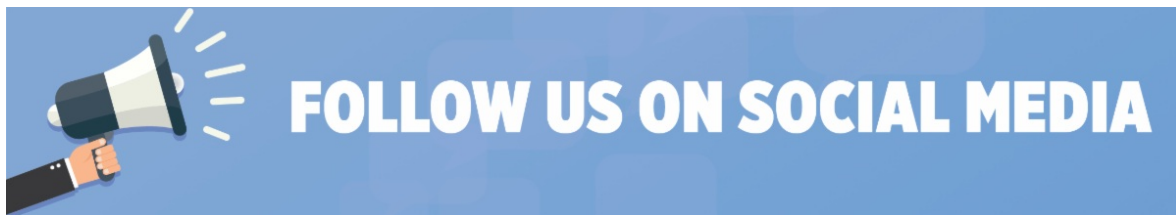
