The Conversation Project Conversation Starter Guide

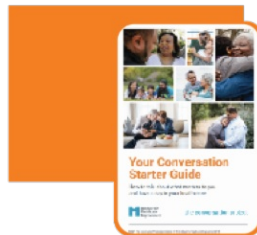
An 11-page guide with open-ended prompts that encourages people talk about their wishes for end-of-life care, share their wishes, consider their values and preferences, and rank their priorities.
