92% of Americans think it's important to discuss their end-of-life wishes. Yet only 32% have actually shared their wishes. (The Conversation Project survey, 2018)

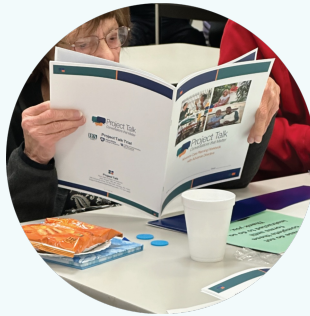
Help low-income and Spanish-speaking communities complete advance directives and make their end-of-life wishes known.

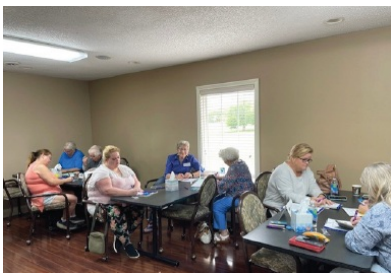
