National Healthcare Decisions Day (NHDD) is dedicated to having meaningful conversations about goals of care & making decisions about your end-of-life care.

This NHDD, help low-income urban and rural communities complete advance directives and make their end-of-life wishes known.

Project Talk is in year 4 of a 5-year research trial and is recruiting only a few more hosts from underserved rural and urban communities to host an event about advance care planning (ACP).

Hosts receive a \$300 grant and event participants can earn up to \$90 in gift cards.
